

Trial halted

Kiev — A Ukrainian Supreme Court trial involving an opposition MP, Stepan Khmara, was suspended indefinitely yesterday after the judge said a gathering of Mr Khmara's supporters in a park near the court constituted "an illegal picket", writes Susan Viets.

Mr Khmara and five colleagues, now witnesses, were arrested following a scuffle last November with an undercover policeman. Mr Khmara is on bail but his colleagues are in prison.
